Foreshadowing (find examples): when the author hints at something that will happen later in the play	
Dramatic irony (find examples): when the audience knows something that the characters don't	
Plot elements in Shakespearean dramas: Act 1: Exposition Act 2: Rising Action Act 3: Climax Act 4: Falling Action Act 5: Resolution	
Foil (examples): Characters that have contrasting personalities	
Imagery and Figurative Language – especially in the speeches of Romeo and Juliet	
Characteristics of a Shakespearean tragedy
